Travel ITINERARY

DAY 1 - TREK FROM RANSI TO CHHOTI BANTOLI (LOWER BANTOLI)



Begin the trek from Ransi, the last motorable point of this route. The well-paved trail begins above the Madhyamaheshwar Ganga river, offering a scenic descent all the way to Chhoti Bantoli. The route is relatively easy as it is mostly downhill and takes approximately 2.5 hours to complete a distance of 7.5 kilometres. The trail is filled with rich biodiversity, thanks to the Kedarnath Wildlife Sanctuary. Along the way, enjoy lush green valleys, wildflowers like *Cosmos Bipinnatus*, and possibly spot some native birds and animals. You will pass through forest patches and hear the sound of the river flowing below. The views are mesmerizing, especially with the deep valley to your right. Reach Lower Bantoli by noon and check-in to one of the basic lodges offering local food and accommodation.

DAY 2 - TREK FROM CHHOTI BANTOLI TO MADHYAMAHESHWAR TEMPLE



This is the toughest part of the trek with a steep ascent of nearly 5,000 feet over a 6.5-kilometre trail. Start your trek by 8 AM after a hearty breakfast at your lodge in Lower Bantoli. As you climb higher, you enter deeper into the Kedarnath Wildlife Sanctuary, one of India's richest biodiversity zones. You'll walk through dense coniferous forests and grasslands with panoramic views of the surrounding valleys. The spiritual aura intensifies as you near the Madhyamaheshwar Temple, a significant stop in the Panch Kedar pilgrimage, believed to be built by Bhima during the Mahabharata era. The temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva, lies in a peaceful meadow and welcomes pilgrims and trekkers alike. Reach the temple complex by noon, explore the surroundings, and rest for the night at the temple guesthouses.



Travel ITINERARY

DAY 3 - TREK FROM MADHYAMAHESHWAR TEMPLE TO BUDA MADMAHESHWAR AND RETURN



Wake up by 4:00 AM and start the 2-kilometre trek to Buda Madmaheshwar to witness one of the most unforgettable sunrises over the Chaukhamba massif. The early morning glow over the snow-clad peaks is a spiritual and visual experience you won't forget. This short yet steep ascent of 875 feet takes about an hour. Carry only essentials in a daypack and leave the rest at your room. At Buda Madmaheshwar, soak in the divine aura, the silence of the Himalayas, and the stunning panoramic views of the peaks. After spending time at the top, descend back to the Madhyamaheshwar temple for breakfast and rest. This concludes the summit portion of your trek, leaving you with a deep sense of accomplishment and peace.

DAY 4 - DRIVE FROM RANSI VILLAGE TO HARIDWAR



Start your return journey from Ransi Village after an early breakfast. - The drive to Haridwar spans approximately 200 kilometers and takes around 7-8 hours. - En route, enjoy beautiful views of the Alaknanda River and pass through quaint Himalayan towns like Ukhimath, Rudraprayag, and Devprayag. Stop for tea breaks or quick meals along the way at roadside dhabas. If time permits, you may pause at Devprayag to witness the holy confluence of the Alaknanda and Bhagirathi rivers that form the Ganga. Reach Haridwar by evening. Check into your hotel or prepare for your onward journey.



INCLUSION

Accommodation: 3 nights of accommodation in Home Stay.

Transportation: Surface transfer from Haridwar to the starting point of the trek and back.

Meals: All vegetarian meals (Breakfast & Dinner)

Guides: Experienced and Qualified Guides to assist you throughout the trek.

Staff: Friendly and supportive staff to enhance your trekking experience.

Sanitation: Sanitized and Hygienic Campsites and Hotels to ensure your safety and comfort.

Permits: Forest permits for your trekking journey.

Medical Amenities - First Aid Kits, Oxymeters, oxygen cylinders.



EXCLUSION

- Anything not in the inclusion list
- Meals during transportation
- Personal expenses
- Unscheduled or extended stays resulting from roadblocks, landslides, or heavy snowfalls.
- Charge for eat mules (personal) and backpack offloading.
- Cost of evacuation in case of emergency

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

- **Age: 12+ years**
- **First Timers:** First timers can apply; previous trekking experience is more appreciated.
- **Fitness Requirement:** The climber must be fit and have sufficient stamina to cover 5 km of distance in 35 minutes without stress.
- **Backpack Requirement:** The climber should be able to carry a 10-15 kg backpack.

- Visit Madmaheshwar Temple, the second Kedar of Panch Kedar dedicated to Lord Shiva.
- Trek through serene alpine meadows, dense forests, and beautiful Himalayan villages.
- Catch a glimpse of snow-covered Chaukhamba and other majestic Himalayan peaks.
- Stay in traditional Garhwali homestays and experience local hospitality.
- Blend of spiritual connection and trekking adventure in the Garhwal Himalayas.

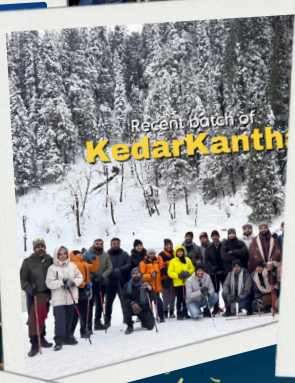
